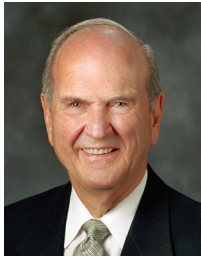

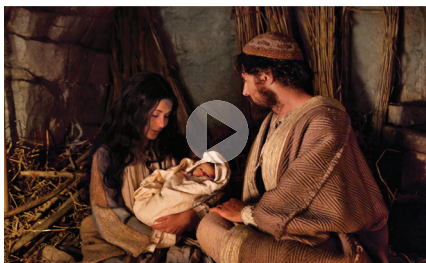
May we find greater holiness in our own lives and *share the gift* with others this Christmas season.

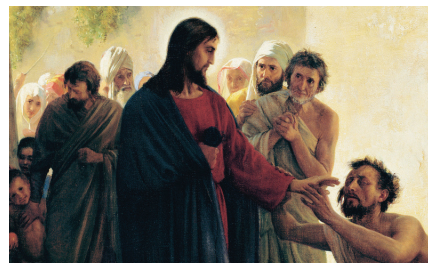
